Attention Extended Care Families (Before School Care, Kids Connection/ After School Care, 3K Lunch Fun and 3K Wrap Care)! We are excited to announce that we are implementing a new check in/out and online bill paying platform for our

Extended Care programs.

Holy Apostles will be using brightwheel to check students in and out for Before School Care, After School Care/Kids Connection, and also to track attendance in the 3K Fun Lunch and Wrap Care programs.

Our go-live date is planned for January 3, 2024. You should have received an email invitation to sign-up to the HA brightwheel community. In the email, tap on create account, and follow the steps to create an account. If you did not receive an email, please email extendedcare@hanb.org so that we can verify your correct email address. Please be sure to set up an account prior to 1/3/24, so that your already enrolled student(s) are active in brightwheel. We encourage you to download the mobile app too!

The new system will also automate and streamline the Extended Care billing process and allow for online payments. Brightwheel will allow you to view your Extended Care account balance, review itemized statements, pay online or autopay, and give you access to year-end tax reports for 2024 and beyond..

This new system will not affect tuition payments. We will continue to use Edutrak for tuition.

In addition to paying by cash/check, you will now be able to pay your invoice through ACH (electronic bank transfer) or credit card. Once an account is created, navigate to the "Payments" section to add your checking account (no fees) or credit card (fees apply) information.
