Though the season was beset with terrible weather, our 57 athletes persevered with a respectable 67 top 3 placements across 6 meets and 29 new entries in the official Holy Apostles Track & Field Record Book.

Eighth grade student, Callie Griffith (left), broke 2 longstanding first place records. Her throw for Shot Put (35' 9.75") beat the record held since 2006 (Jenny Beaudry 29'6.25") by over 6 feet! In Discus, she threw an incredible 97' 8" beating out the previously held record of 70' 4" set by Reenie Ganzer in 2019. Great job, Callie!






