Our renewed tools provide the means for people to make a better life for themselves.

Bring your unwanted tools to the school parking lot at S.159th on Saturday, April 20, between 8:00 am-2:00 pm. We are certified as a charitable organization by the IRS and can give you a receipt for your donation if you wish to have one.

We always need: rakes, shovels, hoes, shears, wheelbarrows, trowels, chisels, pliers, screwdrivers, hammers, saws, wrenches, socket sets, drills, circular saws, sanders, table saws, routers, drill presses, chainsaws, sewing machines, concrete mixers, emergency generators, masonry tools, hardware, nuts, bolts, nails and screws.




