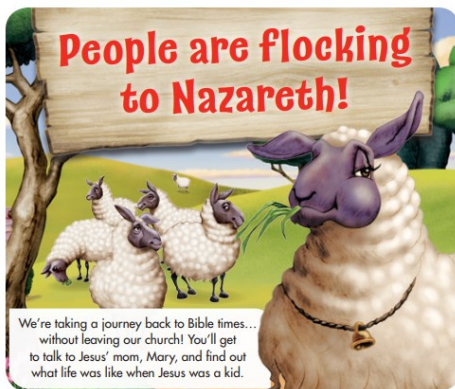
Additional Scholarship Information: Holy Apostles has two scholarships available for the 2024-25 school year. Please consider completing an application:

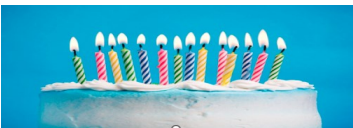
