Moorland Road (County O) Reconstruction Project

PROJECT UPDATE



Moorland Road
WAUKESHA COUNTY

Westbound National Avenue between 159th Street and Coffee Road to Close

Waukesha County, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is underway with reconstructing Moorland Road (County O) between Beloit Road (County I) and National Avenue (County ES). The following work is scheduled as part of this project.

Beginning Monday, March 11 2024:

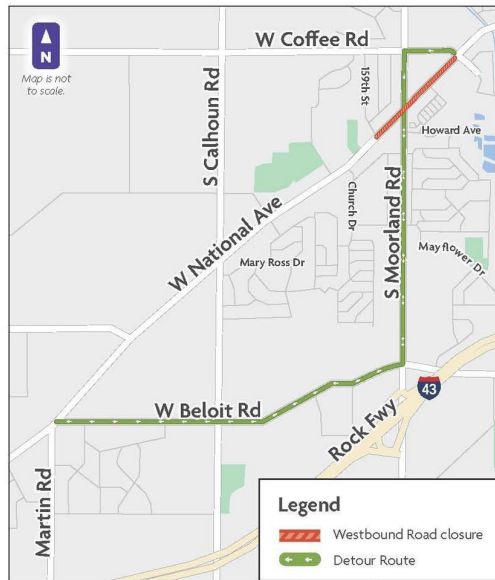
- Westbound National Avenue between 159th Street and Coffee Road is scheduled to close to traffic until early May, while crews reconstruct the eastbound lanes of National Avenue.
- Eastbound National Avenue is scheduled to be reduced to one lane and shifted to the current westbound lanes between 159th Street and Coffee Road until early May, while crews complete reconstruction of National Avenue.
- Short-term lane and shoulder closures are scheduled on Moorland Road between Beloit Road and National Avenue, while crews complete sidewalk installation, and restoration

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

Detour Route

Motorists traveling west on National Avenue are encouraged to use Coffee, Moorland and Beloit roads to get around the closure.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
