Yesterday's Discipleship Wednesday supported [Children's Wisconsin](#). Together we raised \$338! Thank you for supporting this important cause!

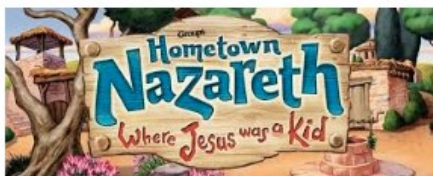
Spring has arrived! Per the [Parent/Student Handbook](#), students can wear shorts beginning on Monday, April 15th.

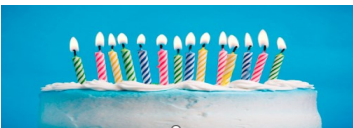
