

FIRST Lego League STATE Competition Results 2024

This past Sunday our HA team 46262 the Ninja Turtles competed in the FIRST Lego League State competition at Madison Technical College. The Ninja Turtles did an awesome job presenting their Innovative Project, answering questions from the judges, and running their robot for the Robot Game. These students should be so proud of all their iterations since Sectionals back in December and at Sunday's competition. There were 302 Wisconsin Lego teams, and by making it to State, the Ninja Turtles were part of the top 26 teams.

Ninja Turtles #46252 (Amelia Ballard, Bella Banton, Holden Benishek, Ally Bindl, Linnea Fisco, Nick Gratz, Morgan Seaverson, Nathan Stepanski, and Finley Sullivan)

Here's how they did:

- *Presented three iterations of their band app, ProPlayer
- *Collected an HA robot high score of 315 points on the Robot Game
- *Added an entire mission at the competition
- *Had no penalties for all three rounds of the Robot Game
- *Competed with the alliance team scoring 360 points
